3 A called meeting of the Council for the City of Covington was held on Tuesday, June 26, 2018 at 6:30 p.m. in Council Chambers of City Hall located at 333 W. Locust Street, Covington, Virginia.

5 Upon a motion by Vice Mayor Crosier, seconded by Mr. Hunter, Council voted 5 to 0 to approve, on second reading, Ordinance O-18-02 Levying Real Estate Taxes and Public Service Taxes for Fiscal Year 2018/2019. (Real Estate increase of \$.04 per \$100). Mayor Sibold – For; Vice Mayor Crosier – For; Councilwoman Beirne – For; Councilman Hunter – For; and Councilman Tucker – For.

1 Upon a motion by Vice Mayor Crosier, seconded by Mr. Hunter, Council voted 5 to 0 to approve, on second reading, Ordinance O-18-03 Levying Personal Property; Machinery and Tools; Mobile Homes and Public Service Corporation taxes for Fiscal Year 2018/2019. Mayor Sibold – For; Vice Mayor Crosier – For; Councilwoman Beirne – For; Councilman Hunter – For; and Councilman Tucker – For.

Upon a motion by Vice Mayor Crosier, seconded by Mr. Tucker, Council voted 5 to 0 to approve, on second reading, Ordinance O-18-04 Amending City Code Section 38 regarding Peter's Mountain Landfill/Collection/Rates and Billings to allow for Adoption of Refuse Disposal and Collection Fees in Solid Waste Fee Schedule. Mayor Sibold – For; Vice Mayor Crosier – For; Councilwoman Beirne – For; Councilman Hunter – For; and Councilman Tucker – For.

t Upon a motion by Vice Mayor Crosier, seconded by Mr. Tucker, Council voted 5 to 0 to approve, on second reading, Ordinance O-18-05 Adopting a Solid Waste Fee Schedule with an increase of \$8.00 per month added to the Utility Bill. Mayor Sibold – For; Vice Mayor Crosier – For; Councilwoman Beirne – For; Councilman Hunter – For; and Councilman Tucker – For.


